WHEREAS:

That according to the opinion Number 0 07/2024 of the General Directorate of Linguistic Planning, the International Seminar meets the requirements established by institutional protocol to be declared of linguistic interest and meets the objectives of the Law Number 0 4251/2010, of Languages;

That the event promotes the linguistic diversity of Paraguay, in compliance with Articles

1, 2 and 3 of the Law of Languages;

That this activity guarantees the survival and functionality of indigenous languages and cultures, as a means to strengthen their ethnic identity, as expressed in Article 12 of Law Number 0 4251/10 of
